NON- RESIDENT LIBRARY CARD

*For those who live in
unincorporated areas.*

If you live in an unincorporated area and the Palos Park Public Library is the closest public library to your home, you can purchase a non-resident Palos Park Public Library card for your household that is good for one year.

As of June 1, 2021, the non-resident fee is \$242.00. This fee is equal to what the Library Tax is currently for residences within the Village of Palos Park limits.

When reviewing your Cook County property tax bill, you will note that you do not pay property taxes for the services of the Palos Park Public Library or the Village of Palos Park as would residents residing within the village boundaries.

Your property tax bill will reflect a line item charge for the Palos Fire Protection District which is a separate entity from the Village of Palos Park.

We hope you will consider purchasing a non-resident card. It opens a world of opportunity!

Non-resident library cards offer the same services as a resident card.

Your library card can be used at 100 libraries in the Chicagoland area.
