

## The Donor Tree Campaign

Your support of the Library allows us to continue providing services and resources to the Palos Park community. Each day, individuals walk through the Library's doors – everyone from local students, families, to retirees, business owners and more. By becoming a donor, you are ensuring that the Library remains the destination for literacy, education, information access, recreation, and life-long learning.

In 2016, through the efforts of the The Board of Library Trustees and staff, the Library's interior was renovated. This project was completed with no additional funds provided to the Library. Presently, however, the exterior and functional workings of the Library building are in need of repair. Annual funds from property taxes are not ample enough to cover the work necessary to guarantee that the building remains safe and operable.

- A large portion of the roof is close to 40 years old and needs to be replaced before there is damage to the building's interior.
- The majority of the lighting fixtures are original to the building and need to be upgraded to energy efficient alternatives that are environmentally sound.
- The HVAC units are at the end of their lifespan and need replacement.

Clearly visible as you enter the library and standing over 6 feet high, the Donor Tree, is a carved glass replica of one of the Library's Red Oaks. Designed by local artist Sheri Law, the tree will be embellished with garnet, copper, gold, ruby, and emerald leaves. Each leaf will be beautifully engraved to acknowledge the donor's generous contribution to the Library.
